SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Galatians 6:1a Brothers and Sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently.

Paul's admonition to the Christians in Galatia demonstrates how uniquely bound we as believers are to one another. Clearly we have a responsibility to not just look the other way, nor diminish the seriousness of the consequences that await those who live sinful lives. As brothers and sisters, we are called to say something to persuade our fellow believers to turn back to a life of Spirit led faithfulness. However, Paul also warns us not to fall prey to temptation when addressing another who has fallen into sin. Begs the question, what temptation(s) is one at risk of being tempted by? Pride comes to mind. Forgetting that it is from sin we have been saved, one may feel they are just enough to call another's sin into question. You may think of another temptation. Whatever the temptation, when it arises, remember the apostle Paul's advise:

"But watch yourselves, or you also may be tempted "Galatians 6:1b.

After all, we who have been saved from our sin should remember most how fortunate we are and be ready to share the same message of salvation with all who will hear it.
