SHEPHERDS' CORNER

CARRY THAT SEED

The year was 1958. It was a time when most people believed that America was good; a time when they expected the country and its servant-leaders to do good; when God was revered and one didn't have to ask, "Which God?"; when marriage was sacred, children had two parents and were taught to respect their elders; when churches were full, the 10 commandments were displayed in schools, and children were sheltered from evil; when people stood for the flag and knelt for Jesus; and everyone declared that we were one nation under God. I remember that time for it was in that year that I was born. I sometimes find myself longing for those days.

Psalm 126 recalls a time, long ago and far away, when God restored the fortunes of his people, the Israelites. It speaks of the joy the captives felt when they got to return to their homeland in Palestine – to Zion. Even the nations around them acknowledged that "*The LORD has done great things for them.*" The psalmist went on to ask the LORD to "*restore our fortunes*" and finishes the psalm with this interesting observation:

"He who goes out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with him."

Today, I often hear people complain about politicians - both democrats and republicans - about bureaucrats and taxes – about racism, sexism, healthcare, the poor, the wealthy, the religious, and the homeless. To be sure, there will always be trouble in this world and admittedly, there is much darkness today. But perhaps in this time, we need people, not only to weep or lament what we have lost – but to "*carry seed to sow.*"

Jesus told us what the seed is that will restore a person or a church or a nation. The seed is the Word of God. It may go out of favor for a season – but it will never fade away. It is the most powerful force for good in this world or the next – by far! So take it with you and share it whenever you can.

"Your word, O LORD, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens."
