# SHEPHERDS' CORNER

## HEARING GOD'S VOICE

"The voice cannot speak what the ear cannot hear". This sums up the life's work of the 20<sup>th</sup> century French audiologist (i.e., ear doctor), Alfred Tomatis. Dr. Tomatis began working with opera singers who were having vocal problems. He discovered that the volume of their own voices was damaging the opera singers' ears so that they lost the ability to hear certain notes. Unable to hear their own voices, they lost the ability to hit those notes. He also discovered that, in order to regain the ability to sing, he had to restore their ears' ability to hear. This phenomenon is known today as the "Tomatis Effect" and a treatment, known as the "Tomatis Method" is a recognized form of therapy. Hearing well is the key to being able to speak – or sing - well.

The Bible tells of how God spoke three times to the mighty prophet, Samuel, when he was a boy. The first two times, Samuel wasn't listening properly, and he missed what God wanted to tell him. He had to receive instruction from Eli, the priest, on HOW to listen. Afterward, when God spoke to him the third time, Samuel's ear was prepared to hear what God said and God revealed his message to Samuel. Afterward, the Bible records that "*The LORD was with Samuel as he grew up, and he let none of his words fall to the ground...*" Samuel words carried tremendous influence all his life. Because he heard – he listened to – the voice of God, his speaking ability was unimpaired. Read about this in 1 Samuel chapter 3.

Do your words sometimes fall to the ground? Do your family, friends, coworkers pay attention to what you say? In short, do they listen to your voice?

Perhaps the more important question has to do with your ears - and not your voice. Are you listening for what God is trying to tell you? Are you humble when somebody offers correction? Are you searching the Bible to learn what God has already revealed? Here are a few thoughts on hearing from the pages of scripture:

*"Everyone who listens to the Father and learns from him comes to me."* (John 6:45)

*"He who belongs to God hears what God says..."* (John 8:47)

*"Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says..."* (James 1:22)

Remember, the voice cannot speak what the ear cannot hear.
