SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Our world is a place of Chaos as we discussed last week. Our lives are moving so fast no one can truly keep up. Some of us are anxious to the point of physical stress. In all of this stress and anxiety we need to remember we are God's children.

Looking at the Apostle Paul, his life was nowhere close to peaceful from being shipwrecked, beaten and thrown into prison. But in every letter he wrote they all start with the wishes for Grace and Peace.

"Grace and peace to you from God our Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 1:7). Paul is not talking of peace as the absence of war, but of spiritual peace. Spiritual Peace: Sense of well-being and fulfillment that comes from God and is dependent on His presence.

In the New Testament peace is the Greek word *eirene* corresponds to the Hebrew *shalom* expressing the idea of peace, well-being, restoration, reconciliation with God, and salvation in the fullest sense.

Next week we will explore how to obtain Spiritual Peace. Start with Jesus Sermon on the Mount (Mat 6:25-34)
