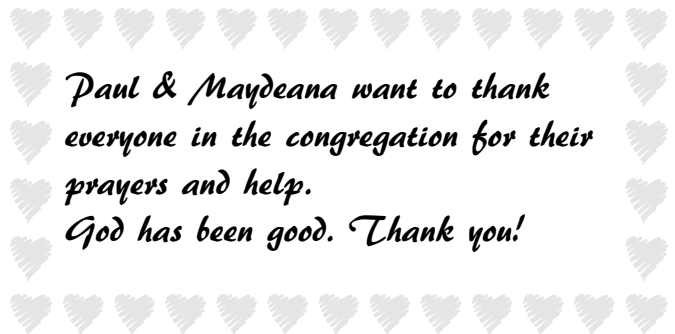
Welcome Visitors!
