

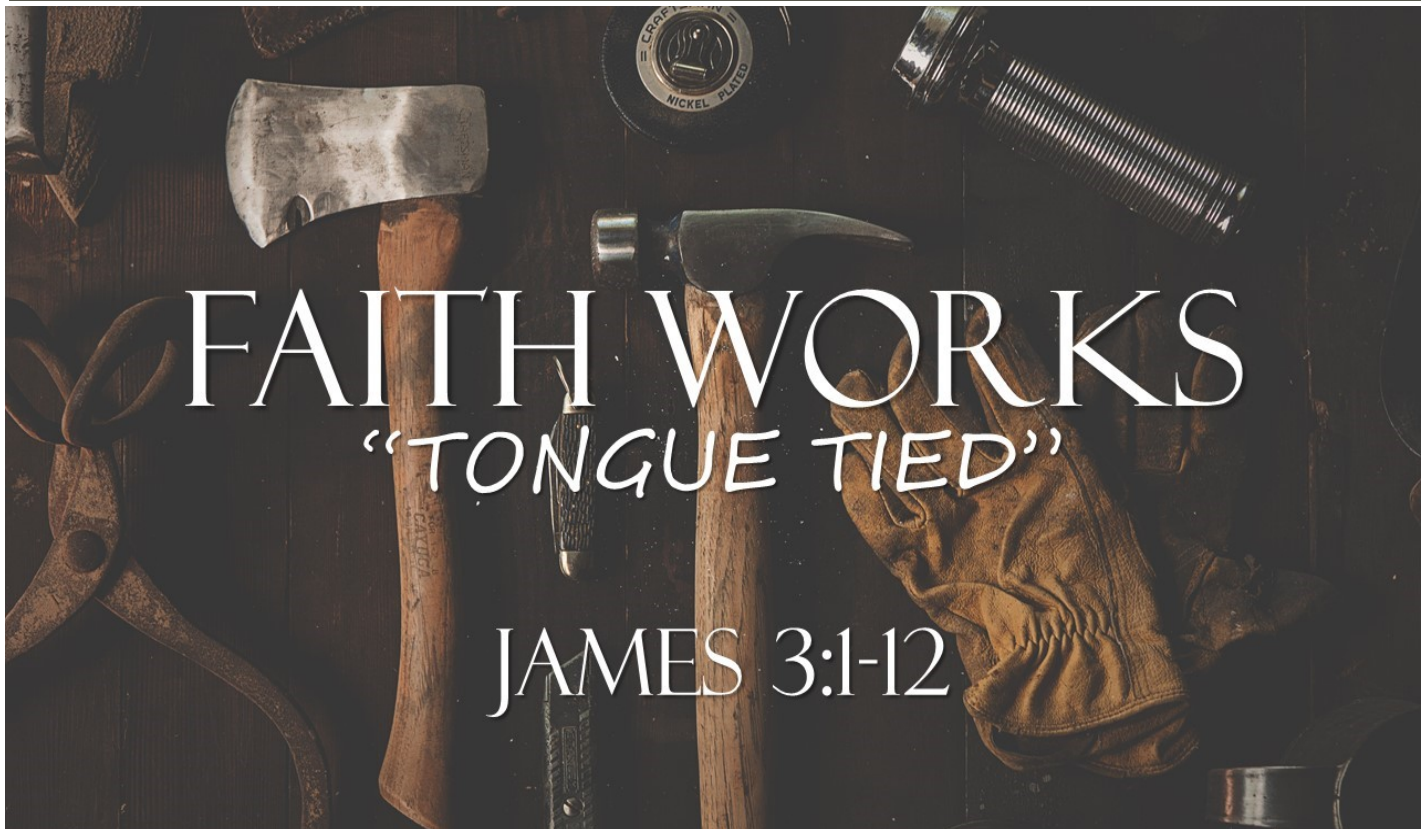

SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Did you know that, during Jesus' time, there were three major Festivals of the Jews. Each year people would journey to the Temple in Jerusalem to participate in these celebrations. The festivals were:

- ~The Feast of Tabernacles in September,
- ~The Feast of Dedication - also known as Hanukkah - in December; and
- ~Passover in April.

Even though the religious authorities in Jerusalem had been wanting to kill him for more than a year (Jn 5:18), Jesus openly went to all three Jewish Festivals during the last year of his life on earth (Jn 7:2; 10:22; and 11:55). At each of these festivals, he went to the Temple Courts, and taught there openly. John's gospel tells us a lot about the things that he taught and what kind of reception he received – how his opponents challenged him by day and schemed to destroy him by night. But Jesus wasn't deterred at all by the danger that he was in. And his twelve disciples, to their credit, were also willing to die with him (Jn 11:16; 13:37). I appreciate the tenacity of Jesus and his followers in doing the Father's will. May you and I learn to be just as tenacious in doing good.

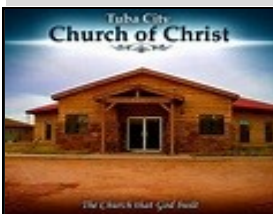
What's your favorite Christmas memory?
