SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Of all the New Testament churches founded by the apostle Paul, none shone brighter than the church in Ephesus. Paul spent more time with this church than he did with any other. They developed a reputation for having great faith and great love for all of God's people, as well as for weeding out false teachers and practices. Perhaps that's why, late in life, both Mary, the mother of Jesus, and the apostle John made their home in Ephesus.

All this was not enough, however. Years after Paul's death in AD 67, Jesus appeared to the apostle John and had him write a letter to the Ephesian church. The letter contained a somber warning. The church it seems had lost something. Jesus said, "...I hold this against you: You have forsaken your first love." We are not told exactly how they had forsaken it. Perhaps after many years the gospel had lost its freshness; or persecution had soured their joy; or maybe even bickering over doctrine. One thing we do know is that the Lord commanded them to "*Repent and do the things you did at first...*"

It is a lesson for our congregation today, who have welcomed and encouraged so many over the years. We can never rest on our laurels but must always continue and maintain our first love.

- Loving God is the greatest commandment
- Loving our neighbor is the second greatest commandment
- Loving each other was Jesus' dying commandment to his disciples
