SHEPHERDS' CORNER

In 2004, The U.S. Olympic Basketball team disappointed when they failed to win a gold medal. Before the Olympics, they had been called the "Dream Team" because there were so many superstars on the team. But during the Olympics, other teams noticed that these superstars were not connected to each other and began to realize that the "Dream Team" could be beaten. For the U.S. team, the Olympics ended in disappointment when they walked away with a bronze medal instead of the gold that everyone had expected them to win.

It's an example of what happens when talented people, not united to each other, try to work together. Although they possess all the raw material they need for success, they don't work as a team, which allows less talented - but more united - teams the opportunity to defeat them.

As believers in Jesus, and in his Word, we have the raw material, right here at Central Kitsap Church of Christ. Combine our faith with the talents that we possess, and we have a collection of superstars – just like that 2004 "Dream Team". But any team - whether in sports, warfare, business, church or family - must work together and be connected to each other to reach its potential. That's why, as believers in Christ, the New Testament repeatedly exhorts us to be considerate and connected with each other. An example is in Ephesians 4:1-3: *"As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. ² Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. ³ Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace."*

On this Fathers' Day, there may be no greater task for the fathers, grandfathers or future fathers among us than to lead our teams to a place of greater connectedness. That's what our Father did for us when we became disconnected from Him.
