

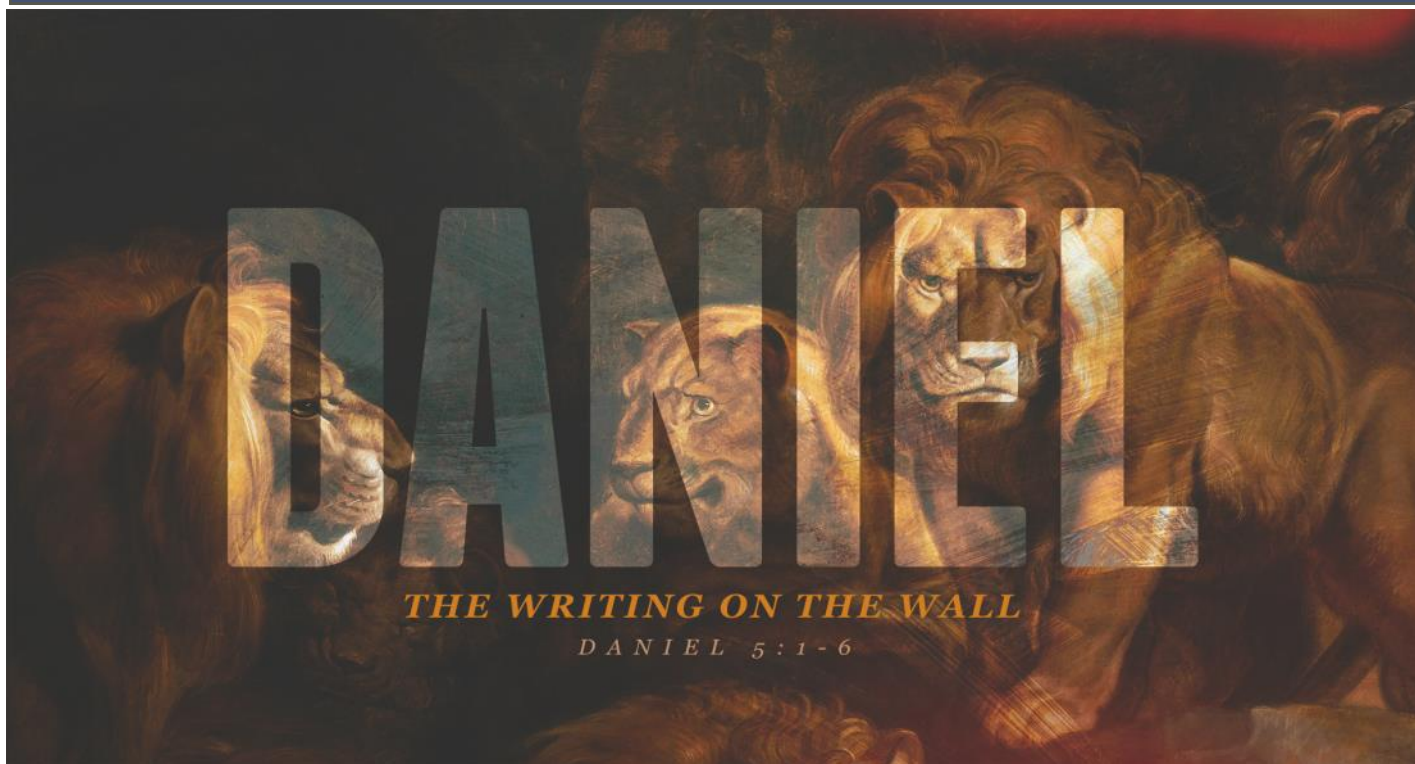

# SHEPHERDS' CORNER

In the first century, the Roman Province of Asia was the richest province in the empire. And the city of Ephesus was the richest city in the province. The source of the Ephesians great wealth was twofold: First, Ephesus was the home of the goddess, Artemis and a large industry of "tourism" existed because people would come from all over to see her and to ask her blessing; Second, it was the port at the end of the great caravan route to the east and an enormous trade existed as a result. In the city, there were two "agora" or marketplaces where much of the world's trade took place. And, in the entrance to these agora, there were shrines to the goddess of the city.

The residents of Ephesus also bought and sold what they needed in the agora. They were to the Ephesians what Costco is to us, if you will. But, whereas Costco charges a membership fee in order to use their store, the price for carrying on business in the agora was to offer a pinch of incense to Artemis. Jews, who had lived in the area for hundreds of years, had an exemption because of their religion. But when the apostle Paul came preaching Jesus to the gentiles (non-Jews), they had no such exemption and it presented an immediate threat to their economic well-being.

Although the Bible is silent on how our early Ephesian brethren resisted, we know that they did. They had to - our faith does not allow us to worship other gods. And it is safe to assume that they didn't stand alone. They had their own community with whom they could trade - the church. No doubt they were worse off economically, being shut out of the city's lucrative trade markets. But, by banding together, they were able to survive. To them, Christ wasn't something they thought about only on Sunday. He was at the center of everything they did. And the church, Christ's family, played a central role in day-to-day living also. Today, the heat is rising in our culture. Many of our beliefs are becoming increasingly unpopular. And some of our brethren are already suffering as a result. We should remember that none of this is new. Jesus warned that we would have trouble in this world (Jn 16:33). And he gave us one another as a means of coping with it. If you haven't done so already, won't you visit one of our small groups this week. Although they are not perfect, they provide an opportunity for greater connectedness in our busy lives - a connectedness that we all increasingly need.
