SHEPHERDS' CORNER

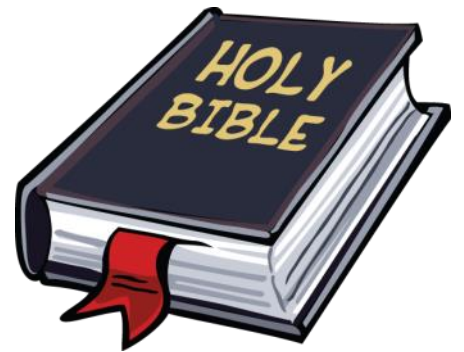
This month we are looking at prayer. Why do we pray?
