# SHEPHERDS' CORNER

## Enduring to the End

Five hundred miles of grueling, intense racing ends with one driver finally crossing the finish line ahead of the others (personally, the races in the animated movie "Cars" were the most exciting to me). While superior preparation and driving skill are no doubt important factors in a race like this, it seems that the greatest accomplishment is simply to finish the race!

An image of sustained perseverance against the toils of this life is written for our consideration by the writer of Hebrews – *"Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,"* (Heb. 12:1).

We are exhorted to run with endurance the race that is set before us. Over and over in Scripture, the triumphant spiritual life is not characterized by a quick sprint, but rather by the completed marathon! A picture of being baptized then sitting back and kicking our feet up with an "I have arrived and have nothing to worry about" attitude is NOT what scripture communicates. God's rewards are promised to those who endure till the end toward the saving of their souls.

It is endurance that bring fruit to our faith and rounds out our character – *"Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing."* (Jas 1:2-4) Endurance overcomes our temptations, proves us, and brings a crown of life – *"Blessed is a man who perseveres under trial; for once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him."* (Jas 1:12)

Life is full of potholes, pit stops, and caution flags. One lap follows another and leads to yet another. Many of us have started the race with high hopes. How many will endure to the end? Will we all see one another at the finish line?
