SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Prophecy in Action

*Thus says the Lord, your Redeemer, and the one who formed you from the womb, "I, the Lord, am the maker of all things, Stretching out the heavens by Myself And spreading out the earth all alone" . . . "It is I who says of **Cyrus**, "He is My shepherd! And he will perform all My desire." And he declares of Jerusalem, "She will be built," And of the temple, "Your foundation will be laid."'" (Isa. 44:24&28; emp. added)*

***Thus says the Lord to Cyrus** His anointed, Whom I have taken by the right hand, To subdue nations before him And to loosen the loins of kings; To open doors before him so that gates will not be shut. I will go before you and make the rough places smooth; I will shatter the doors of bronze and cut through their iron bars. I will give you the treasures of darkness And hidden wealth of secret places, So that you may know that it is I, The Lord, the God of Israel, **who calls you by your name**. For the sake of Jacob My servant, And Israel My chosen one, **I have also called you by your name**; I have given you a title of honor Though you have not known Me. (Isa. 45:1-4; emp. added)*

What's the big deal? God calls a lot of people by name; why not Cyrus? King Cyrus, the supreme king over the Medo-Persian Empire lived from about 580–529BC. In approximately 539 BC, Cyrus allowed about 40,000 Jews who were in captivity in Persia to return to Jerusalem where they were also given permission by Cyrus to rebuild the Temple. The thing that makes the above writings of Isaiah unique is the approximate timeframe that Isaiah wrote them; it was somewhere between 739 – 690 BC.

Isaiah wrote that Cyrus would be responsible for not only allowing Jews to return to their homeland—something that was pretty much unheard of—but also allowed the (re)building the Temple in Jerusalem. If we take the range of years from which Isaiah wrote these "predictions," then subtract the year that Cyrus let the Jews go back to Israel, we have **a prophecy** naming a specific individual and a fairly specific incident occurring 151 – 200 years in Isaiah's future!!

No other supposed prophets in history—other than God's prophets—were ever able to do this! Where did Isaiah get his information? Do we really have to ask?

But know this first of all, that no prophecy of Scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, for no prophecy was ever made by an act of human will, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God. (2 Pet. 1:20-21)
