

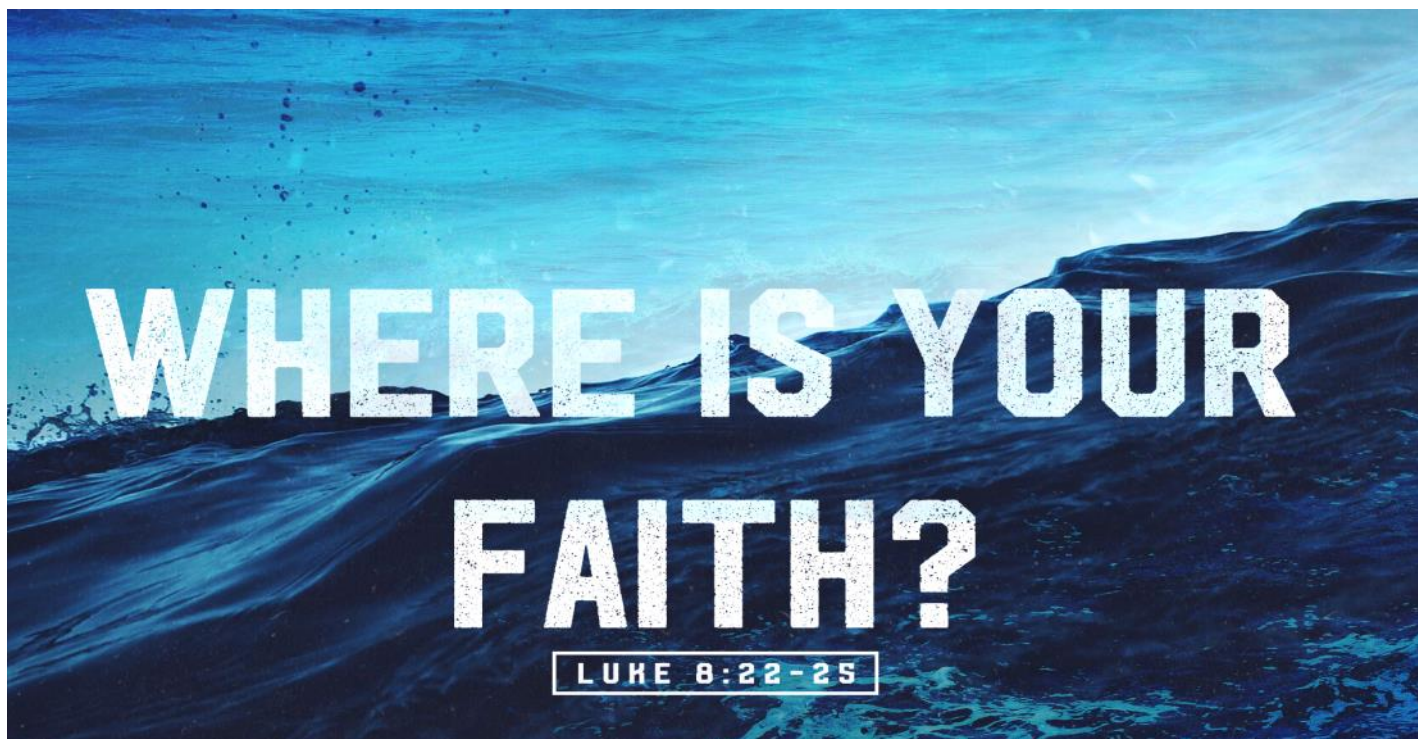

# SHEPHERDS' CORNER

## More Prophecy in Action

Was the New Testament prophesied in the Old Testament?

*"Behold, days are coming," declares the Lord, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them," declares the Lord. "But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the Lord, "I will put My law within them and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. "They will not teach again, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the Lord, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."* (Jer. 31:31-34 repeated verbatim in Heb. 8:8-12; emp. added)

Did it happen?

*But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things to come, He entered through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation; and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? **For this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant**, so that, since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal Inheritance. (Heb. 9:11-15; emp. added)*

Is it working?

*Therefore, brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, **let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.** Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful (Heb. 10:19-23; emp. added)*

What should we do with it?

*Beloved, while I was making every effort to write you about our common salvation, I felt the necessity to write to you appealing that you **contend earnestly for the faith** which was **once for all handed down to the saints.** (Jude 3; emp. added)*

We have the prophecy of a new and better covenant, written between 626 and 586 B.C., fulfilled in Jesus Christ and completely delivered by the end of the first century. The promises of eternal salvation made by God through that covenant are available to us by our obedient faith. May God be praised and blessed for what he has promised and delivered!
