SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Purpose or Motive?

French Abbott and reformer Bernard of Clairvaux (d.1153) is remembered for having stated that "There are those who seek knowledge for the sake of knowledge; that is Curiosity. There are those who seek knowledge to be known by others; that is Vanity. There are those who seek knowledge in order to serve; that is Love.

One is challenged by these thoughts to reflect on one's own pursuit of knowledge and its purpose or motive. As the Psalmist suggests (Psalm 1) blessed is he who delights in the law of the Lord upon which one meditates continually. But the same passage also warns that the Lord watches over the way of the righteous and the wicked; in other words, none escape his sight, nor shall they evade righteous judgement.

With this in mind, and applied to Bernard's thesis, purpose and motive become paramount. As Bernard suggests, the pursuit of knowledge can result in degradation of character if its purpose is to enlarge one's own feelings of self-importance. As James 3:16 suggests, self-ambition and evil go hand in hand. However, knowledge in order to serve is equipping, enabling one to apply knowledge in a way that is self-less.

Consider Jesus' example: King of kings, Lord of lords, Majesty beyond words, choose to walk with, talk with, and be subject to those who by right need kneel before him. Choosing to engage with societal outcasts not just to share in his glory, but entrusting the truth to them, charging them (us) to fulfil his mission of love, despite of mankind's considerable historical and future failed attempts at righteousness. This He called Love. As Paul so eloquently stated in his letter to the Corinthian believers, Love does not dishonor others, is patient and long suffering, and does not keep a record of wrongs (1 Cor 13).

Tis truly better for the believer to choose self-less purpose over self-serving motives.
