SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Once Jesus was asked, "Of all the commandments, which is the most important?" Jesus did not hesitate to answer, "...Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself...'" Loving one another as Jesus would have us do it, presents a powerful witness to all people as noted in the passages below. Note that Jesus spoke these words to his disciples less than 24 hours before he was led to the cross:

John 13:34-35 "A new commandment I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. All men will know that you are my disciples if you love one another."

John 17:20-21 "...I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me."

Years later, the apostle John would sum it up this way:

1 John 3:10 "...Anyone who does not do what is right is not a child of God; neither is anyone who does not love his brother."

1 John 4:12 "No one has ever seen God; but if we love each other, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us."
