## SHEPHERDS' CORNER

One of the most difficult commands given to the New Testament church is the command to "keep the unity of the Spirit". When Jesus departed this earth, his disciples were strongly united by their common experiences. But divisions and factions arose shortly thereafter challenging the church and resulting in numerous appeals for unity from the apostles.

*"I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought." (1Co 1:10)*

*"I gave you milk, not solid food, for you were not yet ready for it. Indeed you are still not ready. You are still worldly. For since there is jealousy and quarreling among you are you not worldly? Are you not acting like mere men?" (1Co 3:2-3)*

It's natural, when deeply-held beliefs are challenged, to avoid controversy by avoiding those with whom we disagree. But Christians are called to a higher standard. The apostles both acknowledged that there would be differences, and instructed us in how to handle them.

*"No doubt there have to be differences to show which of you have God's approval..."*

*(1 Co 11:19)*

*"...And if on some point you think differently, that too God will make clear to you." (Php 3:15)*

*"Accept him whose faith is weak without passing judgement on disputable matters..." (Rom 14:1)*

The idea that we can divide from fellow believers over such issues as various worship practices, or interpretations of various doctrines is anathema and completely counter to the teaching that there is only one church (Eph 4:4). Dividing, ignoring, gossiping, arguing and the like are natural (and worldly) responses when deeply-held beliefs are challenged. But they are not how the apostles instructed us to deal with difficult issues.

*"Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love." (Eph 4:2)*

God's word never has, and never will, lead us astray. And that word insists that, as fellow members of God's family, we love, accept, bear with, greet, and forgive one another.
