SHEPHERDS' CORNER

One day, beside the Sea of Galilee, Jesus told a story to the crowds that had gathered to hear him teach. We know this story as the Parable of the Weeds. A little later the same day, He explained its meaning to his disciples. Read about it in Mt 13:24-30 and Mt 13:36-43. Some of the key points of the parable are:

The sons of the kingdom of heaven and the sons of the evil one grow side by side in the kingdom

The LORD's servants, troubled by this, naturally want to root out the sons of the evil one

The LORD doesn't want his servants to do this for fear of rooting out sons of the kingdom along with them.

Instead, the LORD asks that his servants trust Him with their judgment and be willing to wait until "the end of the age".

If we take the kingdom to be referring to the church, then we need to realize that we are stuck, for now, with things that cause sin and those who do evil (Mt 13:41). We can never completely differentiate or eliminate them. Although we may wish for a pure church (and we do), the reality seems to be that there will always be those among us who are insincere. Like the servants in the parable, the LORD asks us to exercise patience. Except for cases of blatant and obvious sin, we are to wait patiently for His judgement to be revealed.

It is enough for us to teach the truth, as we understand it from the Bible. But we should all exercise caution in judging those, both within our congregation or in other Christian groups, for fear that "*while you are pulling up the weeds, you may root up the wheat with them.*" (Mt 13:29)

"...judge nothing before the appointed time; wait until the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of the heart. At that time each will receive their praise from God."

(1 Cor 4:5)
