SHEPHERDS' CORNER

In Ephesians chapter 3, Paul spoke of the “Mystery of Christ” which had been hidden for ages and was now revealed. During the discussion, he mentioned the church, saying, “...His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms...” (Eph 3:10) Obviously, the LORD had BIG plans for the church extending far beyond our understanding (“to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms”). But, in a practical sense, how do we recognize the church and participate in “the manifold wisdom of God”?

Some have contended that the church consists only of those groups who organize after a particular pattern; or who worship a particular way or at a particular time. Some even say that all churches must be identical in areas such as these in order to be recognized as a true church. Sadly Christ's followers have divided over issues such as these. But Jesus gave a different criterion on how His disciples – His church - would be recognized.

“A new commandment I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. All men will know that you are my disciples if you love one another.” (Jn 13:4)

Love is the defining characteristic and the distinctive nature of the churches of Christ.

While the Bible speaks to the other issues, and they must be addressed in every congregation, love must be preserved at all costs. When disagreements arise over various issues, as they certainly must (1Cor 11:19), it is the way in which we resolve these issues, not just the resolution itself, that defines us as Christ's disciples. If Jesus and his apostles were clear on anything, it is that love for one another was the key issue then – and it remains so today.
