



SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Why Study God's Word?

Just as we eat three meals a day to sustain our physical bodies, we must also feast on God's word daily to sustain our souls. It may seem like a silly question, but what would happen if we stopped eating? God says in Hosea 4:6, "*My people are destroyed for a lack of knowledge.*" Just as starvation leads to weakness, malnutrition, and death, people can suffer from spiritual starvation that will ultimately lead to spiritual death.

Satan wants to distract us with the cares and allurements of this world. He does *not* want us becoming familiar with what we need to know to be pleasing to God, not to mention reading and studying our Bibles every day (I guess I just mentioned it). Satan knows that we become spiritually weak and vulnerable when we fail to study.

Our strongest defense is the spiritual armor provided by God. How do we obtain that shield of faith to protect us? Ephesians 6:10-13 says: "*Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm.*" In verses 14-17, he identifies the parts of that armor. The more we study the word of God the stronger our faith will be. If we want to protect ourselves against Satan we *must* have a strong faith.

Let us not find ourselves wandering around in spiritual darkness. Let's study God's word so that we can be like King David who wrote:

O how I love Your law! It is my meditation all the day. Your commandments make me wiser than my enemies, for they are ever mine. I have more insight than all my teachers, for Your testimonies are my meditation. I understand more than the aged because I have observed Your precepts. I have restrained my feet from every evil way, that I may keep Your word. I have not turned aside from Your ordinances, for You Yourself have taught me. How sweet are Your words to my taste! Yes, sweeter than honey to my mouth! From Your precepts I get understanding; therefore I hate every false way. Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path. I have sworn and I will confirm it, that I will keep Your righteous ordinances.

Psa. 119: 97-106)

Take time to study God's word often.
