

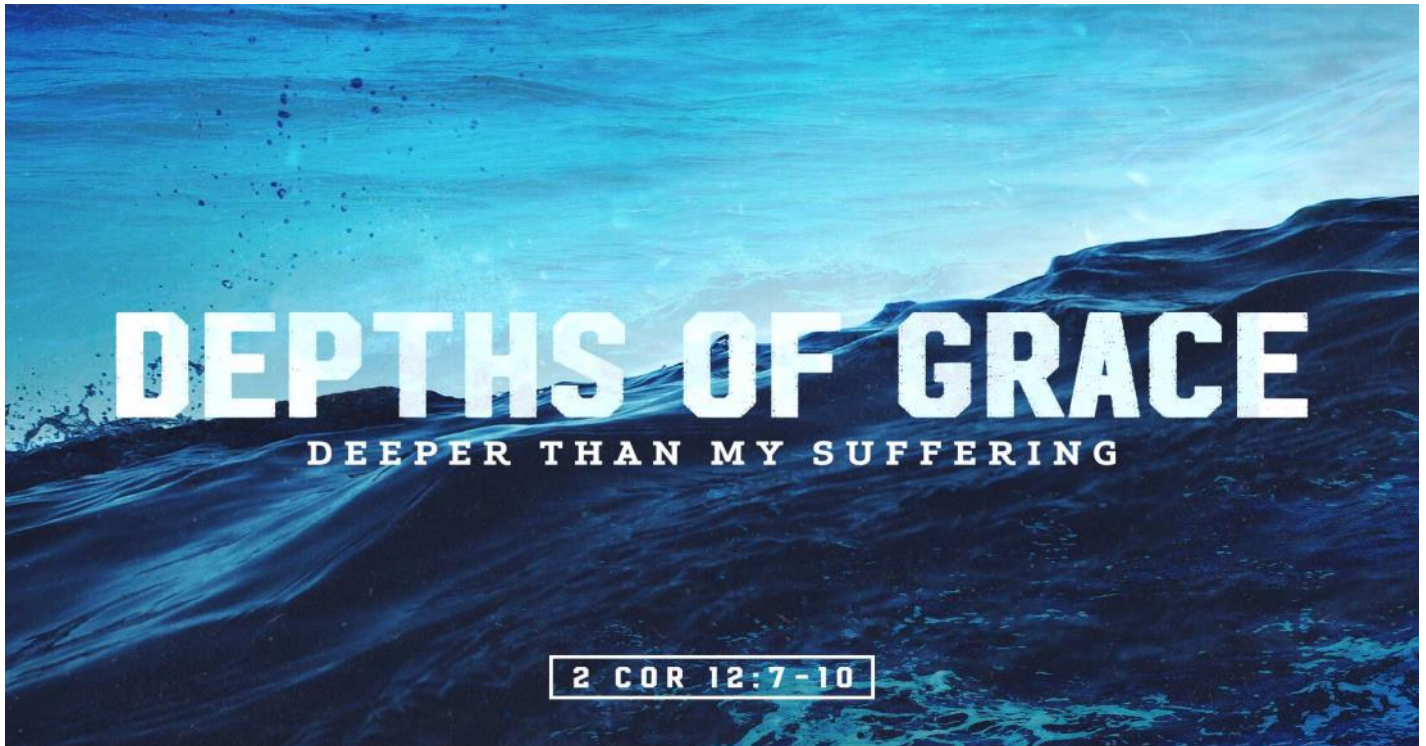

SHEPHERDS' CORNER

In Genesis, the book about the beginning of all things, the Bible states,

"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them...and it was so. God saw all that he had made and it was very good. And there was evening and there was morning – the sixth day." (Gen 1:27-31)

And so the human race was born – created in, and bearing, the image of God. The Bible makes no mention of race beyond describing all of us as members of the human race. And if you think about it, that's the only race that matters. Humans alone bear the image of God and are therefore precious – each and every one.

In recent weeks we've heard a lot about how "Black Lives Matter. Other groups and slogans have also arisen: "Native Lives Matter"; "White Lives Matter"; "All Lives Matter". The reality is that all these slogans are true. What is sometimes lost in the discussion seems to be the reason why these lives actually matter. Our lives are important for the simple reason that they are important to God. Without that acknowledgement, our lives really wouldn't matter very much. In the same way, the civil rights movement spread in this country under the passionate preaching of a pastor from Montgomery, AL. Our hope and prayer is that Biblical truth, and Biblical preaching might continue to guide and shape the ongoing discussion. As the song says, "Red and yellow, black and white, they are precious in his sight..."

Here is an excerpt from the newsletter from the children's home in Oaxaca, MX affirming the positive things that have happened amid all the trials of late:

Thanks to friends and partners like you, we have been sustained financially and have not had to consider laying off any of our valuable staff.

Being stuck at the Mission has provided a lot of time for one on one discipleship with our children as they are there all the time. I have loved seeing pictures on social media of the creative ways our staff are entertaining and developing our kids.

We had dreamed and planned to start a junior high at our Baja Mission so that we can continue educating and discipling our children during their most vulnerable years. Because the kids are now home anyway, the principal Cheryl Trevor, decided we would just start now. Different staff are jumping in to cover the teacher roles.

We have been able to minister in the communities around the missions by giving away needed groceries and supplies. This is a wonderful opportunity to be the hands and feet of Jesus.

Resuming In Person Worship Services

Your Leadership, along with the help of a few members of the congregations are working hard to reopen the church building. Stay tuned to this week's online service to hear more about the progress taking place to resume in person services.

Even though we will soon be meeting back in the building, please understand NO ONE is obligated to be at services. If you are not feeling well, feel unsafe, or you are an at-risk person, we want you know that it is OK not attend worship services in the church building. Services will continue to be streamed for those of you that would prefer to stay at home. Also, we will have to maintain the 6-foot social distancing and wear face masks during services. Unfortunately, the playground will remain off limits to our children at this time.
