

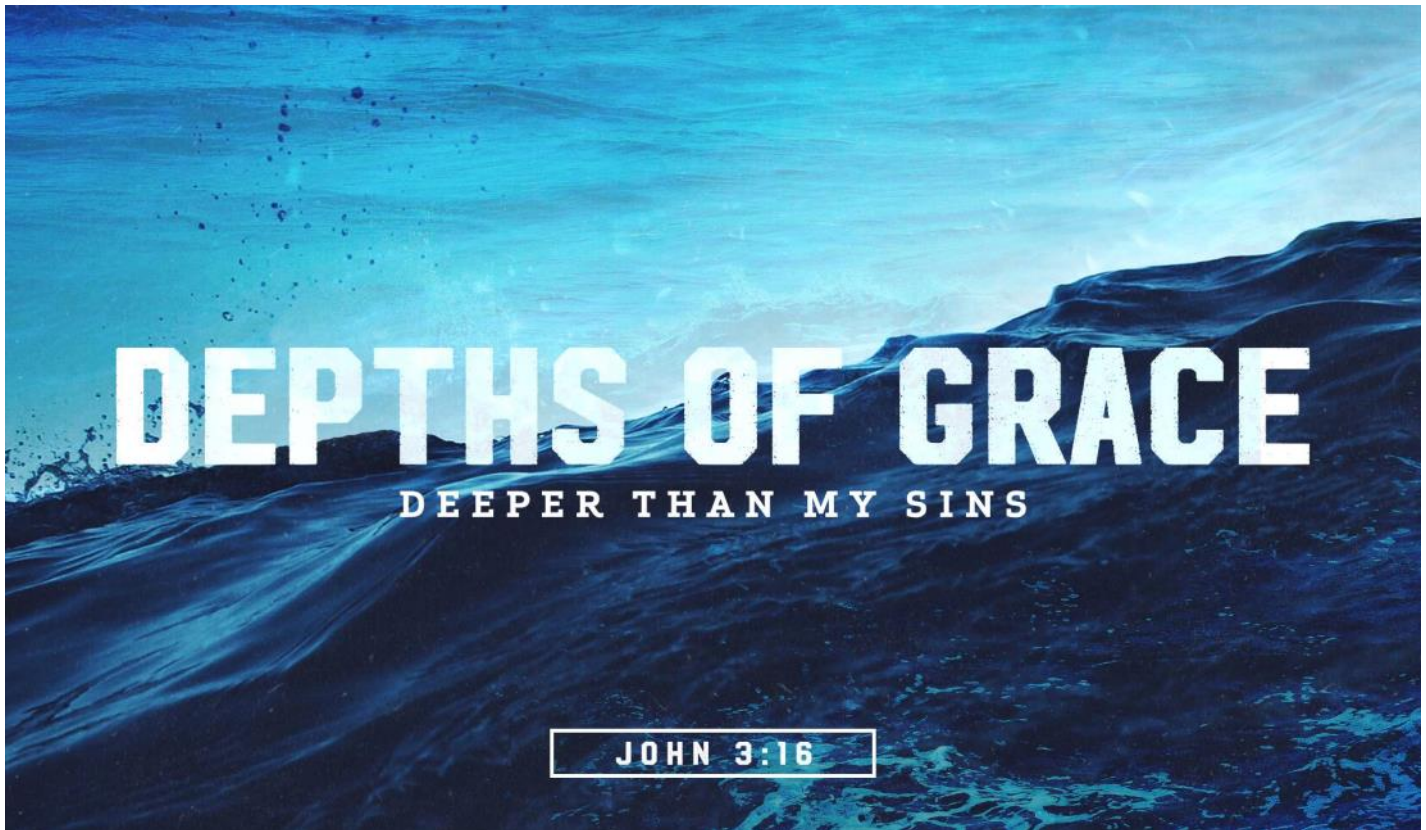

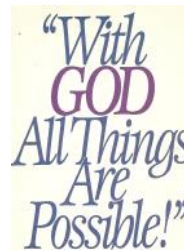
Attention CK Kids

Dear Central Kitsap Church Of Christ,

On a Friday night in June, one of the youth from the Oasis Center asked Jacob Wischoff, the Manager of our Oasis Centers, if he could give him a ride home. It was an extended ride home because they were leaving the Port Orchard Center and the youth lives in East Bremerton.

As they drove, the young man told Jacob about his family and they talked about what it was like to grow up in Bremerton. He explained how his dad had been in and out of incarceration due to addiction and that because of that they were separated and his father was now living in another state. He described his relationship with his father as nonexistent. Jacob felt compassion for this young man and offered to be like a dad to him if he wanted. While the young man accepted Jacob's offer, he also warned Jacob that he doesn't get too close to people because he's afraid that they will one day walk out on him.

Over the next couple of weeks, Jacob got to know this young man better and learned more about his story. This young man was separated from both his parents. He had a baby on the way with a girlfriend whose parents hated him. And he's only 18 years old. He says he gets high every day because he has nothing else going on and feels he doesn't have anything or anyone. He even told Jacob he probably wouldn't be around much anymore. Yet each day, just like clock work, he keeps showing up.

Jacob hopes to continue meeting and sharing with this young man, so he can come and see for himself that Jesus desires him to be in relationship with him.

We have such an incredible opportunity to love and inspire the youth we serve. We get to meet these youth wherever they are at, whatever they are going through, and mirror what Jesus did. He built relationships and talked about real life issues. And as these issues became known to Jesus, he didn't fear and shy away. But he spoke the truth and invited them into a relationship with him. Truth wasn't shame, it was the good news he was bringing them.

Thank you for helping us share hope and truth with youth in Kitsap and Pierce County! We are grateful for you!
