SHEPHERDS' CORNER

One day while out canvassing a neighborhood in search of new business, I met an elderly woman who had been watching TV. The front door was open as I approached, and you could hear the TV news channel from the front porch. My door-knock interrupted her programming and the conversation on her doorstep was short. But I still remember the last thing she said before I left. "I have to get back to my program so I know what to be mad about."

Today, it's easier than ever to be mad. Republicans don't like what Democrats are up to and vice versa. People are mad that they must wear a mask; others are mad because some people are not wearing them. Lawlessness has broken out in several American cities, including Seattle. There's police brutality, racism, unemployment, vagrancy, corruption... And the list goes on. 24/7 TV news and analysis, social media and talk radio constantly encourage us to get mad.

None of these are trivial issues and there is good reason to be concerned. But thinking too much about disturbing things that we CANNOT control is harmful. Prayer is a better alternative. Think about it. When you pray about an issue – any issue – that you CANNOT control, you are bringing that issue to someone who CAN control it. With this in mind, might we suggest limiting the time you devote to news and current events. It will all go on with or without you. Rather than allowing others to make you mad, listen to the one who will bring you peace. The apostle Paul put it this way:

"Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable – if anything is excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me – put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you." (Philippians 4:8-9)

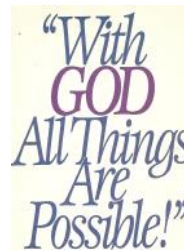
Attention CK Kids
