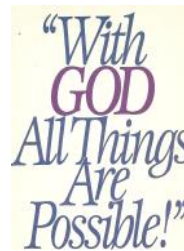

## Baby Shower Postponed

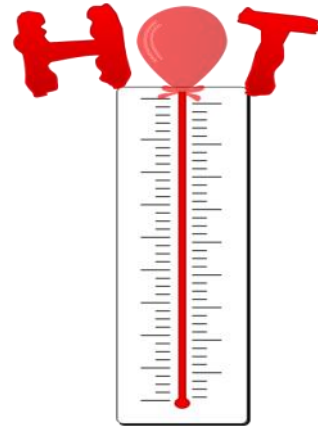
Due to unforeseen events and no fault of their own, the adoption that Marissa and Seth were pursuing is, at this point, not going to happen.
