Three Minutes with God

Daily Meditations

Monday, July 22, 2019

On a Hillside in Galilee

On the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee, between a place called Tagbah (“the seven springs”), and the fishing village of Capernaum, is a vibrant, green hillside in the shape of an amphitheater. It is a place with such perfect acoustics; one man can converse with thousands.

“Now, when he saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, and he began to teach them, saying ...”

Today, open your Bibles with me to Matthew chapters 5, 6, and 7. Read the greatest sermon ever preached. Try to listen to it as if for the first time. The sermon has two parts: attitudes for discipleship, 5:1-12; and lessons for discipleship, 5:13-7:27. It contains lessons about the Law, 5:17-48; lessons about God, chapter 6; and lessons about judgment, chapter 7.

The controlling theme of the sermon is the call to be different: “Do not be like them” (6:8). Sometimes, Jesus contrasts his followers with everyone else. They are polite to their friends. They greet each other, but Christians greet their enemies (5:44-47). Pagans babble their prayers, but disciples know God listens to them (6:7-13). Others find self-worth in possessions. Christians know self-worth comes from a relationship with the Lord (6:32-33). Jesus even contrasts his followers with the religious people of his day. “You have heard it said ...” (5:21-48), and “Do not be like the hypocrites” (6:1-18).

After you read the Sermon, you won’t need me to tell you why we need to spend more time studying it. The Sermon on the Mount shows us our deep need for God. Living the sermon is the best means to show others what it means to know Jesus. Finally, the more we try to live these lessons, the more we receive God’s blessings!
