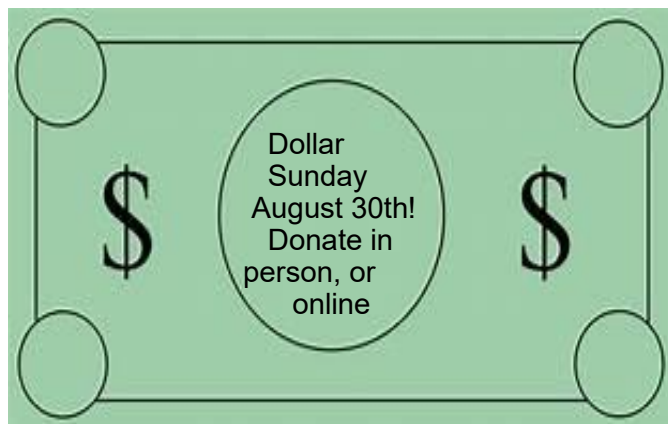

So, You Have Cancer Now What?

A year ago, I was diagnosed with terminal liver cancer, and doctors predicted I'd have three years to live. While undergoing treatment, I asked myself some questions on how to prepare for death. Will my wife be financially secure? Am I prepared for eternity? And many other questions. If you or a loved one has a terminal diagnosis, I pray my answers will help you along your journey.

Glenn Goree has over thirty years of counseling experience. He and his wife worked as missionaries in Rhodesia, Africa for six years. During the terrorist war afflicting the country, he assisted in civilian/paramilitary counter insurgency programs. He later became a medic in the Rhodesian army.

After the family returned to Texas, he established Glenn Goree and Associates. He has provided crisis counseling in Morocco, Jordan, and Afghanistan, as well as in many local areas. Glenn currently serves as a mental health consultant for a global company with offices in San Antonio, and is an area coordinator for counseling services for another company headquartered in Wisconsin. He is also Director of the counseling program for a large church in San Antonio. He holds an M. A. and M. Ed. degrees, and is a Licensed Professional Counselor.
