SHEPHERDS' CORNER

Is Just Knowing Him Enough?

Have you ever seen one of those optical illusions like the cube that you can't tell if it's up, outside and to the right or down, inside, and to the left (or was that the other way around?)? Or a picture that asks, "Is this a decorative vase or two faces?" Words can do that too. I have a book entitled "Eats Shoots and Leaves." What can a statement like that mean? Is it referring to someone who has a meal, fires a gun, and walks out, or an animal that eats plant roots and foliage (it's a book about punctuation)?

I read about a sign on a small billboard in front of a church stating, "Satan knows Jesus and he isn't in Heaven." 'Excuse me?!? Oh, wait. Is this one of those cute tricks with words or just a mistake with punctuation? It turns out that the idea attempting to be conveyed was that Satan is not in heaven just because he knows Jesus (punctuation and context can change the meaning of a statement in a heartbeat).

Stop and think about that. Satan knows Jesus, so why isn't Satan in Heaven? Satan does not reside in Heaven, because, even though he knows God, he has never taken God seriously enough to change his ways. So this means that just knowing Jesus doesn't get you into Heaven. Just knowing about Jesus, His life story, and the things He's done isn't enough. James wrote: "*You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder.*" (Jas. 2:19)(I have often wondered about that. If the demons believe and are fearful, why are they still demons? Another question for God when I see Him).

The Bible is often called the book knowledge. One may know the stories and the facts but that doesn't do it; it goes so much further. You need a balance of heart knowledge and head knowledge coupled with a longing to love and honor God through obedience to His will, and a deep desire to be His child and follow him. Knowing Jesus on any terms other than His will not gain us a place in Heaven, regardless of the amount of sincerity we may have. Jesus said, "*Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.'*" (Matt. 7:21-23)

My heart goes out to those with a presumptive attitude who say, "Oh, I'm not worried. I know Jesus, and I know He loves me and would never condemn me to hell – if there really is a hell, that is." Make sure your will, heart, and head all belong to Jesus.

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me, and I give eternal life to them, and they will never perish; and no one will snatch them out of my hand. (Jn 10:27-28)
